The number of references is restricted to 3, preferably citing your own publications. The references [1] should be cited in square brackets [2,3].

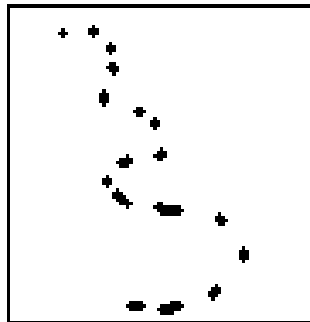

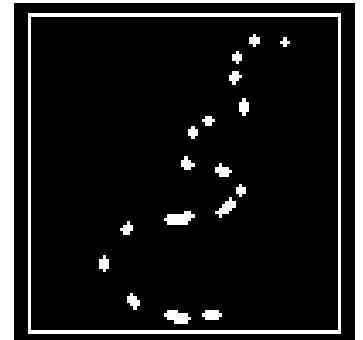
If this serves a better understanding, 1–2 figures may be embedded in the minipage environment.
